# VanEck and EasyBourse launch cooperation on ETFs and ETNs in France

- **EasyBourse clients can now buy 23 ETFs (including 20 listed on Euronext Paris) and 7 ETNs (all listed on Euronext Paris) issued by VanEck with reduced brokerage fees until the end of 2025.**

**Paris, March 4<sup>th</sup>, 2025** – The international asset manager VanEck and the online brokerage platform EasyBourse are launching a partnership giving French investors access to 23 VanEck ETFs (Exchange Traded Funds) and 7 ETNs (Exchange Traded Notes) with reduced fees in 2025. As part of the cooperation, EasyBourse will reimburse its customers 100 per cent of brokerage fees on all available VanEck ETFs and ETNs. This offer is valid until 31 December 2025 for buying orders from EUR 1,500 to EUR 20,000, with a limit of 5 refunds per customer per month.
