Under Dutch law, VanEck ETFs N.V. has segregated liability between its sub-funds. VanEck ETFs N.V. does currently not offer an exchange of shares for shares of another sub-fund. The shares are admitted for trading on various stock exchanges and can be traded on the secondary market. The price of the shares offered on the secondary market may deviate from the net asset value of the shares.

Objective:	 The VanEck World Equily Index (gross total return index) as closely as possible. The reference index measures the performance of share markets in developed countries throughout the world. The index consists of markets such as Australia, Belgium, Canada, Finland, France, Germany, Denmark, Hong Kong, Italy, Japan, the Netherland Norway, Singapore, Spain, the United Kingdom, the United States, South Korea, Sweden and Switzerland. The Product is passively managed and invests in the underlying (physical) securities that make up the index and does not ler the underlying securities out to third parties.
