

# MOTG - VanEck Morningstar Global Wide Moat ETF

VanEck Morningstar Global Wide Moat ETF seeks to replicate as closely as possible, before fees and expenses, the price and yield performance of the Morningstar® Global Wide Moat Focus Index⁵. The index provides exposure to companies with Morningstar® Economic Moat™ ratings of wide that are trading at the lowest current market price/fair value ratios. The index follows a staggered rebalancing approach in which the index is divided into two subportfolios, each containing 50 stocks. One sub-portfolio reconstitutes in December and June; the other subportfolio reconstitutes in March and September. The information here pertains only to the subportfolio being reconstituted.
