VanEck Announces Change to ETF Product Line



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New York, NY, (January 24, 2025) –VanEck is pleased to announce that the Board of Trustees of VanEck ETF Trust approved a 5-for-1 forward stock split for the <u>VanEck Environmental Services ETF (NYSE Arca: EVX)</u> ("the Fund").

Shares of the Fund will begin trading on the split-adjusted basis at market open on February 6, 2025. The Fund will retain the same CUSIP and continue to trade on The NYSE Arca Exchange under the same ticker symbol, as set forth below. There will be no impact on the overall value of the ETF. The Depository Trust Company ("DTC"), the registered owner of all Fund shares, has been notified of the split and has been instructed to adjust each shareholder's investment accordingly.
